joined the Reformed Church in 1614, he published a Confession of Faith...

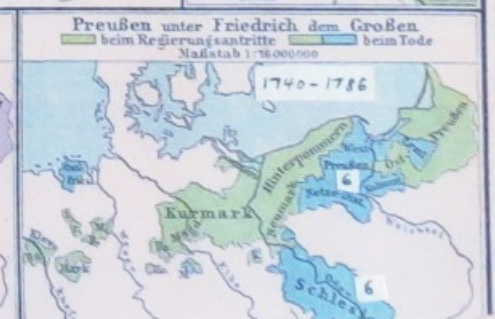
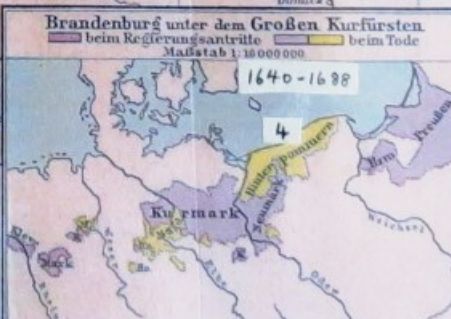

Churches under Ministry of Public Worship
2) 1817
Union Decree to bind the two Churches
3) 1821
"Wende" in order of worship in imposed
4) 1823
Substitution to Lutheran Confession as was nullified
5) 30 April 1830
Union imposed
6) 28 Feb 1834
Union modified to confederation
7) 4 April 1834
Acting for legislative freedom of Religion
